The October 3 Rivers outing was held at <u>Boomland RV Park & Campground in</u> Charleston, MO. It was attended by the Fords and Hunters. No business meeting was held do the low attendance.

We went into Charleston and spoke at length with the Chamber of Commerce. The woman there told us a lot of the history of the area. She pointed out that Charleston is the home of Governor Warren Hearnes and that his wife Betty still lives and is as sharp as ever. The Hearnes museum will be open during the festival.

We had a great time exploring Boomland, Charleston and the surrounding area. Boomtown was started 60 years ago as fireworks stand and has been expanding ever since. There are 3 locations, but Charleston is by far the biggest. We met Wallace Reeves the owner sitting just inside the main entrance one morning on our way to breakfast in Wally's Cafeteria. He talked our ears off and gave each of us an addition game on the back of his business cards – we all failed the quiz!

The Boomland RV Park just upped their rates from \$12/night all the way up to \$15 on September 1<sup>st</sup>. The sites are all pull throughs with many 50amp sites. We paid with credit cards at the Boomland store counter. Boomland itself is a HUGE store where you can find all sort of souvenirs, supplies and adornments but they don't carry any liquor or beer. At one end is a HUGE fireworks store about the same size as the main store. Gas was selling for \$2.29<sup>9</sup> outside the store.

We took a side trip across the Mississippi and Ohio Rivers and ended up in Wickliffe, KY. From there, we drove through Cairo, IL before heading back across another bridge toward Charleston. We missed stopping at a couple of museums but plan on taking them in during our next visit. We saw the confluence of the Mississippi and Ohio Rivers from the bridges. The Mississippi turns the cleaner Ohio muddy in a big hurry.

The next day, we drove down to New Madrid using the county roads and toured the museum there. As a bonus, we managed to find a thrift shop there in downtown New Madrid before returning to the campground.

No trip to Charleston would be complete with a trip to Sikeston and Lambert's Café and some "throwed rolls! Yum!

We made reservations for the campground for 5 spaces for April 16-19 during Charleston's Dogwood & Azalea Festival and hope everyone will be able to make Three River's first campout of the new year. They don't normally take reservation except for holidays and the festival. Mark your calendars! We had a great time and saw a lot but there's still a lot more to take in – there's never enough time! Keep Bette and I up to date on your plans to attend and we'll deal with the park.
