**August 14-16:** Campout at the Tievoli Hills Resort, 25795 Hwy N, Clarksville, MO 63336, (573) 242-3577. You can find the Resort on Facebook. **Note: The campground has asked that each rig confirm your registration personally.** 

DIRECTIONS: From I-70 west of St. Louis, take Hwy 79 north 60 miles to Clarksville. Two miles past Clarksville take Hwy N about 4 miles south and west. When you pass County Road 233 the resort will be on the left.
